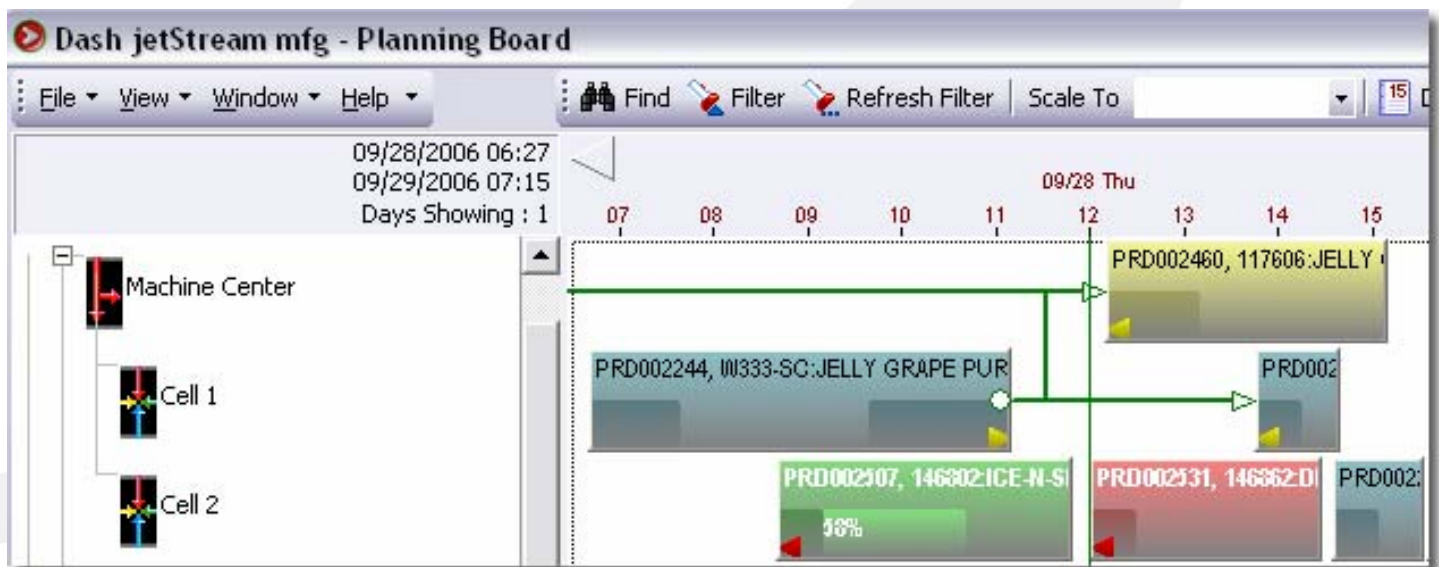

You need *jetStream* if...

- Traditional Shop Floor Control software is too cumbersome and complicated.
- You need to eliminate delays, waste and mistakes due to paper-driven processes.
- You need an easy way to plan, execute and track production that doesn't get in your way.
- You communicate using a magnet board, Kan-Ban cards, white board or paper lists and orders.
- You're employing concepts embodied in Lean Manufacturing, Flow Manufacturing, Kan-Ban, Cellular Manufacturing and/or Pull methods of production.



New in *jetStream* 2

➤ **Multi-Step Processes** - *jetStream* now supports complex relationships between Operations (predecessor and successor) - visually linking together various steps in a process. Each Operation can contain multiple successors and/or predecessors.

Each relationship may also contain it's own *minimum off-set* hours to allow for fine-tuning the process – useful for processes that may require wait time between operations - like drying time - or planned overlap (negative wait time).

There's also a new *Visual Alarm* displayed if the rules imposed by the relationships are

violated (Ex: Step 2 comes before step 1). See Picture above.

➤ **TCM® Routings Interface** - Standard hours are retrieved from TCM's Standard Routings. Setup and Productive operations are combined in *jetStream* to make a single Task (or operation). Your routing may be a simple 1 step, or many.

➤ **A New Look** - a face lift gives the product a familiar Office 2003 look, complete with dockable and customizable tool-bars.

➤ **TCM v8.1 integration** - now available

➤ **Dock-able Windows** - All of the various portions of the display are now dock-able. This means you can re-arrange your screen in any way that works best for you – including moving some portions completely off of the *jetStream* window. You can also save and retrieve your window arrangements as different “desktops”

➤ **Auto-Sequencing logic** - to allow sequencing of the Tasks within a Resource based on a “Group Code”. Additional options can force sequencing to schedule within production periods (Example: Schedule white, then red, then black, for the week 1, then repeat that sequence for week 2, etc).

jetStream also preserves it's existing *Reshuffle* which operates purely on priority scheme based on relative start time.

Both options work to assist the Planning by quickly arranging Tasks in their proper sequence, and compress/remove out slack time throughout the schedule.

➤ **Auto-Assignment:** We've implemented auto-assignment logic for special imports. This automatically assigns a Task to it's preferred Resource, in an appropriate sequence, as dictated by TCM's Standard Routings Department/Work Center and Group Codes. This feature also includes options to impose some production period boundaries into which a Task must/should be slotted.

➤ **Import/Export:** A manual import/export infrastructure as an alternative to the automatic, real-time updates. (Import, develop your plan, then export back to the host). This supplies the infrastructure to implement custom import & export routines.

➤ **Hide / Show Days & Hours** – keep nights and nights from consuming valuable screen real estate.

➤ **Microsoft SQL Server support**

It's a simple, visual alternative to Shop Floor Control, Job Cost and Data Collection.
